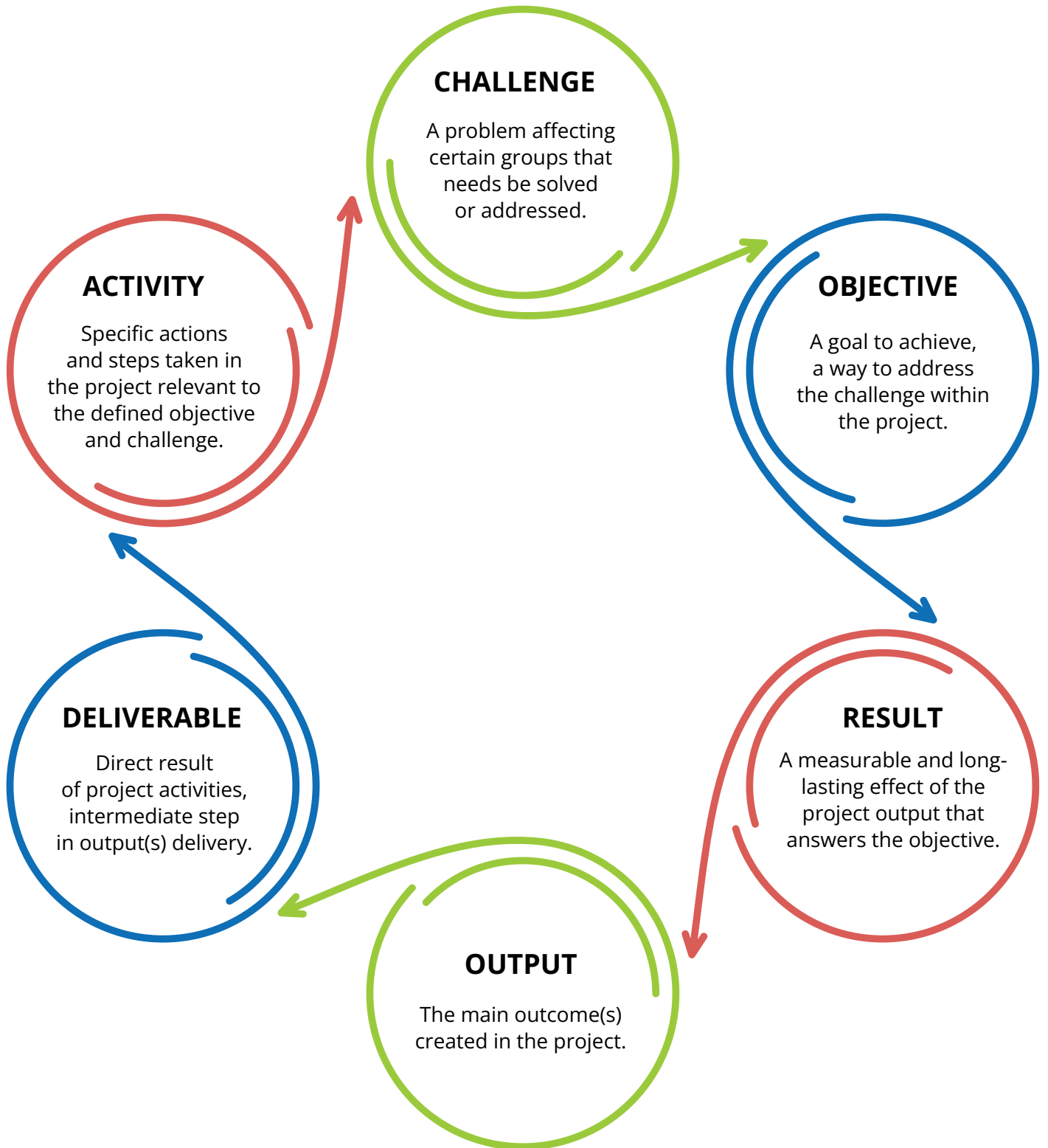

THE PROGRAMME GLOSSARY

CHALLENGE (OR AN OPPORTUNITY)

The challenge at the cross-border level lies at the core of the cooperation.

- Common or similar problems/ opportunities identified in different areas of the South Baltic region.
- Supported with statistical data.
- Demonstrated need for target groups.

OBJECTIVE

The objective shows the need for cross-border cooperation and development of joint solutions.

- The value of and need for cross-border approaches and cooperation.
- Expected improvement(s) if the goal is achieved.
- Expected benefits for target groups.

RESULT

Result is a long-lasting answer to the defined challenge.

Project result should correlate with the pre-defined Programme result indicators.

- Programme results indicators are defined for every Programme Measure.
- Programme result indicators are identified with limitations/ applied with rules (e.g., values, identifications).
- Achievement should be demonstrated with the final report.

OUTPUT

Output is the main project outcome cumulating the project implementation.

Project output should correlate with the pre-defined Programme output indicators.

- Programme output indicators are defined for every Programme Measure.
- Programme output indicators are identified with limitations/ applied with rules (e.g., values, identifications).
- Achieved by the end of the project implementation period.

DELIVERABLE

Deliverable is the tangible or intangible product resulting from activities' implementation.

- Milestones in the output delivery.
- Programme defines up to 3 deliverables for each content-related work package (in total up to 12).
- Each deliverable should be identified with a value and period of realisation.

ACTIVITY

Particular actions and steps planned in the project.

- Activities contribute to the achievement of deliverables.
- Programme separately defines up to 6 management activities.
- Programme defines up to 10 activities for each content-related work package (in total max up to 40).
