Joint Programming Committee and Working Groups

- The Joint Programming Committee has met 7 times since February 2020
- The external company was contracted in June 2020, which results to:
 - socio-economic analysis, SWOT/TOWS and POT
 - proposal of the Programme Strategy, Priority Axes and Specific Objectives
- Two Working Groups have met 15 times up to now







The interest of the Programme members

- Build on the experience from previous Programme perspective
- Keep the focus on small, local institutions
- Follow people to people character of the future projects
- Focus on a vision: "United by the Sea into action for a blue and green future Innovative, Sustainable, Attractive and Active South Baltic"







The interest of the Programme members

- The Programme aims to introduce as many administrative and financial simplifications as possible
- The budget for the Programme is likely to be adopted at the similar level
- Programme stakeholders are in favor of keeping comparable level of co-financing if regulations permit
- Seed Money calls will be launched to prepare to the next programming period







The Programme 2021-2027

- What will be continued:
 - Support for green tech development (water, energy and circular economy),
 mobility, cooperation capacity, internationalization od SMEs, tourism
- What is new:
 - Support for digitalization
 - Extending the Programme's impact at private sector including SMEs as direct project partners
 - Intensifying the use of simplified cost options
 - Extending the Programme area








The Programme 2021-2027 thematic focus

 - M2.2 Promoting sustainable use of water
 - M2.3 Supporting a circular and more resource efficient development
- PA 3 Attractive South Baltic –activate the tourist potential of the South Baltic
 Area
 - M3.1 Promoting a sustainable and innovative tourism development
- PA 4 Active South Baltic -improving cooperation governance
 - M4.1 Strengthen the cooperation capacity of actors based within the South Baltic Area (including civil society)

- subregion olsztyński, as part of the Programme








Next steps

- Lunching public consultations of the draft the Programme Document and of the Strategic environmental assessment prognosis
 August – October 2021
- Seed money call dedicated for the future
 September November 2021
- National approvals of draft Programme until the end of December 2021
- Commission approvalI-II quarter 2022 (expected)
- Launching the new Programme preferably II quarter 2022
